Trip details: The team will arrive in Nassau, Bahamas and spend the night there. The next morning, the team will fly out to Fresh Creek, Andros (Bahamas) to complete work on Phase 2 of Mission Andros Hope. Phase 2 consists of building a basketball court for youth in the community of Love Hill, Andros in order to help them grow their passions and achieve their purpose through the sport of basketball. The team will assist with pouring the concrete slab for the court, installing the basketball goal, and assembling the outdoor court tiles with lines that will sit on top of the concrete slab. The team will spend several nights in Andros and then return to Nassau on Saturday evening. On Sunday morning, the team will attend church services at Golden Gates Native Baptist Church before having free time in Nassau that afternoon. The team will return to the U.S. on Monday.

Trip Costs: The *estimated cost of the trip for five (5) nights is \$2,100 and includes accommodations, roundtrip flights from Northwest Arkansas to Nassau and from Nassau to Andros, all meals, ground transportation, and administrative fees.
